## Foam Cleaning – Equipment, Walls, Ceilings & Floors

- 1. Gather all necessary tools, chemicals and personal protective equipment.
- 2. Remove all product and packaging material from the processing area.
- J. Dry clean soil from surfaces and surrounding areas.
  Sweep, shovel or squeegee debris into proper disposal container.
- 4. Pre-rinse all surfaces with hot water using a water hose and move hose stream from side to side, starting at the top of equipment and working down.

Foam Cleaning – Equipment, Walls, Ceilings & Floors

- 5. Foam Enrich No. 299 at 2-3 oz/gal to surfaces. Apply the foam starting from the bottom of the surface and work towards the top. Apply foam to the floors as well.
- 6. Allow foam contact time of 5-10 minutes, being careful not to let foam dry. NOTE: Any areas with particularly difficult soils should be hand scrubbed with a brush while the foam is on the surface.
- 7. Thoroughly rinse detergent from all surfaces using a high pressure hose. Be careful not to soil already cleaned equipment.

- 8. Inspect all surfaces for cleanliness. Re-foam, hand scrub and rinse if necessary.
- 9. Sanitize using San-I-King No. 451 at the rate of 1 ounce per 5 gallons of water, in a foamer, to be sprayed over the surfaces.
