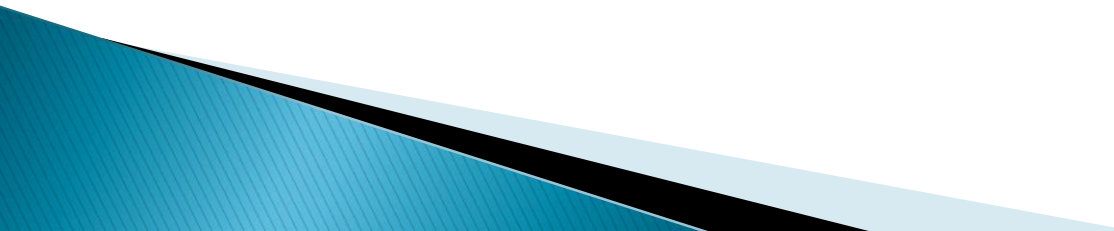




Good Manufacturing Practices

February–Clothing and Personal Equipment

Laundry & Approved Clothing

- ▶ Washable food industry towels will be laundered and maintained by the employer.
 - ▶ Personnel, contractors and visitors who work in or enter areas where products, ingredients or primary packaging are exposed must wear appropriate clothing that is clean and in good condition.
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Laundry & Approved Clothing

- Work wear must be provided, laundered and maintained by the employer.
- Employees WILL NOT launder their own uniforms.



Laundry & Approved Clothing

- ▶ Where laundry service is provided, collection points for soiled work wear must be separated from food production or packaging area.



Laundry & Approved Clothing



- ▶ Employees who work in the facility will wear **ONLY** company–approved clothing.
- ▶ Full time employees will wear company provided shirts appropriately snapped to an acceptable height and pants along with dedicated footwear.



Laundry & Approved Clothing

- ▶ Initial and part-time employees will wear a company-issued white shirt and scrub pants, along with dedicated footwear.



Laundry & Approved Clothing

- ▶ If an undershirt is worn, it must NOT have any hoods, buttons or pockets.

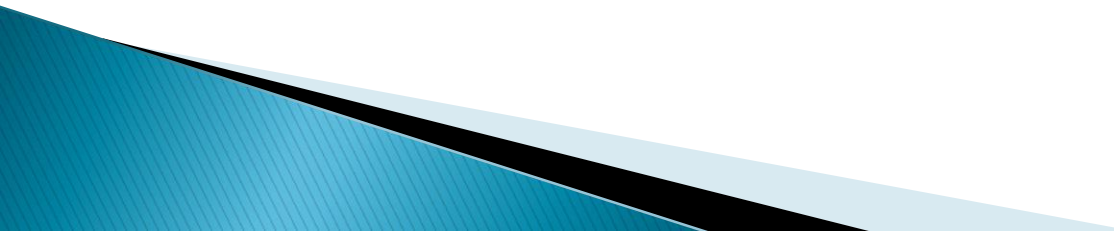


Laundry & Approved Clothing

- ▶ Disposable sleeve protectors must be worn when in contact with product or product contact surfaces and must be worn while lidding in a packaging line due to the possibility of a broken seal. Sleeves are intended for a single day's use, if stored in a sanitary manner when leaving the workstation. Sleeves must be replaced if they become soiled or contaminated. Sleeve protectors must not be worn in the break room, restroom or outside. While working in a wet environment, arm hair must be covered with gloves that go past the elbow, when working in an open Brine Vat or brined tub.
- ▶ Exceptions: Feta Production employees, Blue Production employees and working on packaging line while boxing.



Laundry & Approved Clothing

- ▶ Clothing shall provide adequate coverage to ensure that hair, perspiration or other foreign materials DO NOT contaminate the product.
 - ▶ All clothing must be free of potentially offensive markings.
 - ▶ Pockets above the waist **MUST** be removed or sewn shut.
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Laundry & Approved Clothing

- ▶ Only zippers, Velcro or snaps may be used as the fasteners on shirts, coats, laboratory jackets or smocks.



Changing Facilities

- ▶ Changing facilities shall be provided for all personnel, whether it is staff, visitor or a contractor.
- ▶ These shall be sited to allow access to the production, packaging or storage areas.
