Purpose:

Train employees on how to prevent and control the entrance of pests into the facility.

Problems caused by pests:

- 1. Damage to food, supplies and facilities.
- 2. They can contaminate food and food contact surfaces.
- 3. They can spread diseases.

Pest Management program should:

- 1. Emphasize sanitation and exclusion of the pests.
- 2. Train employees
- 3. Use a licensed pest control operator (PCO).

Our current pest management provider is Eco-Lab. They visit the facility 2 times a month.

Common pest problems in this region are:

- 1. Rodents (Mice and Rats)
- 2. Flying insects (House flies, fruit flies, drain flies, etc.)

To combat the common pests in this region EcoLab uses:

- 1. Pest traps which are located throughout the facility. (Rodents)
- 2. Bait stations are located around the exterior of the premises. (Rodents)
- 3. Light traps are located throughout the inside of the facility. (Insects)

The biggest prevention – Keeping doors closed as much as possible, good housekeeping and sanitation.

EcoLab has a pest log book. This log allows for communication to the pest control provider. If employees notice pests or pest activity, communicate this to your Department Head and/or Quality Assurance so it can be recorded into the pest log book and be addressed by the pest control provider.

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
