

Employee Training Manual Extraneous Matter

- Extraneous Matter is anything that is found in our product or ingredients that should not be there.
 - Glass & Brittle plastics
 - Glass should not be taken into production room environments. If glass is required it shall be shatter proof or safety coated to prevent breakage.
 - Any detection of broken glass in open product areas shall result in the immediate shut down of the line for cleanup and investigation.



- Control for brittle plastics
 - Documented pre-production and post production checks are performed each shift for brittle plastic items in that production area that could be broken during normal production.
 - Any detection of brittle plastics in open product areas shall result in immediate shut down of the line for cleanup and investigation.
- This facility has a glass and brittle plastic register which is audited each month.

- Metal
 - A pre-operational inspection is done to ensure that there are no loose or missing parts or wear on moving parts at the startup of each production day in each production area.
 - Preventative maintenance is done to ensure that equipment does not become a source of metal contamination.

Metal Detection

- Finished product is run through metal detection equipment.
- Metal detector operating settings are set at the most sensitive detection level possible for metal in the product without generating false rejects.
- All metal detectors in the facility detect for:
 - Ferrous
 - Non-Ferrous
 - Stainless Steel

• If extraneous material is found it shall be reported to the quality assurance department for notification and investigative purposes.



- An extraneous matter report shall be filled out and contain the following:
 - Date found
 - Time found
 - Name of person who found it
 - Department it was found in
 - Was it found in the cheese
 - What was found
 - Who was notified
 - Was the source found, if so what was the source
 - What was done to correct the problem
